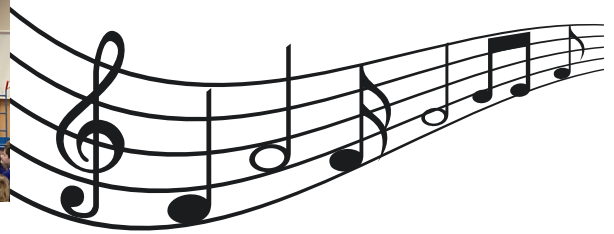
# Take a look at what has been happening at Pittington Primary School ...



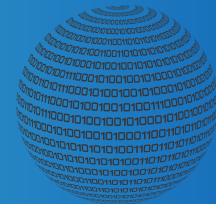

Year 5 have been continuing our work with the BBC Micro:bits to create coding for step trackers.



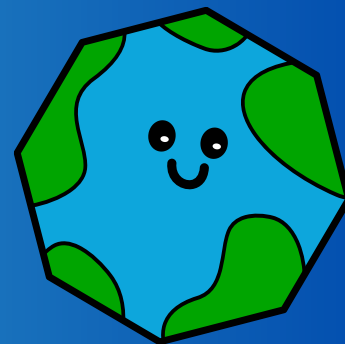

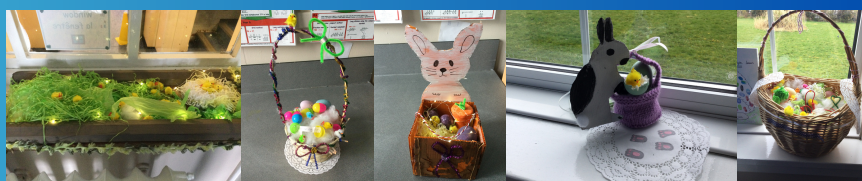
Mr Wright picked his winners who were awarded in our Celebration Assembly.
